


**ROSEBUD COURT OF RECORD
JUDGE'S STANDING ORDER NO. 14**

Standing Order Enjoining the Recording of Proceedings

Under penalty of Contempt of Court, no person, other than the Court Reporter or Court's electronic recording system, may record a court proceeding without the Court's permission. In addition to person in the courtroom, this prohibition applies to members of the public watching the proceedings on the Court's YouTube Channel and to persons with the ability to record via online meeting applications, including but not limited to Zoom, GoToMeeting, etc. The Court Reporter's record or Court's electronic recording system shall be the only record of the court proceeding. Any person found to be in violation of this order faces a contempt proceeding which may result in a fine up to \$500 and confinement in jail for each act of contempt.
